## **RE: Extra-Curricular Opportunities for Students**

We are delighted to inform you of the extra-curricular opportunities available to students this term. As a school, we have always offered a wide range of enrichment opportunities to students (both at lunchtimes and after school) and encourage them to take part in activities outside of their timetabled lessons. Our aim is to provide memorable experiences outside of the classroom that will enrich their school experience and support their personal development.

The school's Learning and Resource Centre (LRC) is open to students is open at break and lunchtimes every day for students to loan books, read, or use the space to study independently. It is also open after school on Monday and Thursdays until 5 pm. All students in Years 7, 8 and 9 will have a fortnightly slot in their English lessons to exchange books and browse the wide range of titles on offer.

This year we have launched a new homework club. This will take place in IT1 every lunchtime and provides a quiet space - with access to computers - for students to complete their homework and receive support in school should they need it.

Our twilight buses run on Monday and Thursday evenings. Our non-service bus routes will leave at 4.45 pm (as all extra-curricular sessions finish at 4.30 pm). Students should contact Ace Reception at 4.45 pm in the unlikely event that their bus or taxi hasn't arrived. These buses leave from the Twilight bus Stop at the rear of the leisure centre:

- Green route
- Blue route
- White route
- Purple extension route (beyond Wetwang)

The yellow and orange service routes will continue to leave from Bridlington Road and the purple route to Wetwang also leaves from the Twilight Bus Stop at the rear of the leisure centre. Students should collect a booklet of tickets from the ACE reception and for travel on the purple extension route, book a seat on the day of travel at the ACE reception by the end of lunchtime. Please ensure that students have a mobile phone in their bags to be able to contact you in the unlikely event that there is an issue with the service route. Please see the attached map for full details of each bus route.
