## **RE: Parental Workshops**

Earlier this academic year we launched the first of our workshops that are planned to support parents and carers in our school community.

The first of these parental workshops were held during the school day looking at literacy and numeracy support strategies. We are now repeating these as twilight sessions on Thursday 1 December. We are also offering an additional session on this evening delivered by MIND on "How to deal with anxiety". All three sessions will be running at the same time so you would only be able to attend one of them on this evening. Should these prove popular, we will offer them again later in the academic year so that parents and carers can come to a different session at that time. Specialist teachers from our English and mathematics departments as well as a colleague from MIND will be delivering the sessions.

The events will be on Thursday 1 December and will start from 4.45 pm with tea, coffee and cake available in the ACE building where the main school reception is. There is a planned start for the sessions of 5 pm. The sessions will last approximately thirty minutes with an opportunity for any questions at the end.


